#### Beyond the Badge: Dr. Madhva Nagarhalli on NAAC's Evolving Vision for Educational Quality

Dr. Madhva Nagarhalli, Director, SCOE, recently elaborated on the forthcoming Maturity Based Graded Level accreditation policy, which will soon be open for public feedback. This new system, as explained by NAAC Chairman Anil Sahasrabudhe, marks a significant shift from the previous broadbrush grading, introducing a tiered approach with stringent parameters. Reaching the highest levels, Level 4 or 5, will present a considerable challenge even for well-established institutions due to the multi-layered methodology. NAAC also announced a binary accreditation process where

thanks to Mr. Abhinandan Kondekar institutions will simply be marked as 'accredited' or 'still-to-be accredited'. While new institutions will undergo basic accreditation, those previously accredited can opt for the more rigorous Maturity Based Graded Level accreditation. This updated methodology, developed based on the Dr. Radhakrishnan Committee's recommendations. emphasizes continuous improvement and sets hiah benchmarks. making progression through the levels particularly to Level 4 or 5 — far more demanding than the easier A or A++ grades of the past. This initiative signifies a fundamental redefinition of educational quality, viewing it as an evolving continuum rather than a static achievement, with a new accreditation portal set to launch and the old system being phased out.

India's leading technological institutes, including the IITs, IISc, and BITS, are rapidly transforming into vibrant innovation hubs, fostering a new generation of deep-tech entrepreneurs from within their faculty ranks.
